



HDSA Annual Convention Scholarship 2017: *Wisconsin*



The Huntington's Disease Society of America will be hosting the 32nd Annual HDSA Convention in Schaumburg, IL on June 22-24, 2017. To help more families participate, we are pleased to announce the creation of a financial aid scholarship for individuals and/or families living in Wisconsin who wish to attend the Annual Convention. We are accepting applications through Wednesday, April 19, 2017. Applicants will be notified no later than Friday, May 5, 2017 as to whether they have been awarded a scholarship.

This fund was established to benefit individuals and families affected by Huntington's disease and is made possible through the generous support of the Rockford IceHogs.

Scholarship Availability & Application

- The intent of this scholarship is to help families and individuals who live in the state of Wisconsin to attend the 32nd Annual HDSA Convention.
- The scholarship is open to any family member or caregiver who is affected by Huntington's disease.
- All scholarship recipients are required to attend the Convention events beginning on Thursday evening, June 22nd and ending on Saturday, June 24th.

What does the scholarship cover?

- **A Full Scholarship:** A full scholarship recipient will receive funding to cover hotel accommodations at the Renaissance Schaumburg Convention Center Hotel (you may be asked to share a room with other scholarship recipients) and Convention registration, which includes your ticket to the Convention Gala on Saturday. If driving, roundtrip mileage is reimbursable at 53.5 cents per mile up to 500 miles roundtrip (**distance to be calculated on Google Maps**); If flying, roundtrip airfare is reimbursable up to \$400 per person for up to four family members (**please note you must book and pay for your airfare and you will be reimbursed at the Convention**).
- **A Partial Scholarship:** A partial scholarship may be awarded when the total amount of funds in the overall scholarship fund will not allow for a full scholarship. Any person may also request a partial scholarship if they are able to pay for some portion of their costs and only require partial assistance.
