## Compensation:

You will be paid \$25.00 for completing the study. We will also reimburse travel expenses for car-alternative transportation up to \$50.00. By participating, you may help us learn how to benefit patients in the future.

## Procedures

Option 1: You will collect your saliva for 3 days (a total of 12 times) prior to an in-person visit at the VA Portland Health Care System. The visit will last approximately 30 minutes and will involve completion of some mood and quality of life questionnaires and a Huntington’s disease assessment.

Option 2: You will have **two** visits to the VA Portland Health Care System. The first visit will last approximately 30 minutes and will involve completion of some mood and quality of life questionnaires and a Huntington’s disease assessment. You will collect your saliva for 3 days (a total of 12 times), complete diaries, and wear sensors prior to the second visit. The second visit will last approximately 5 minutes and will involve returning the sensors, diaries, and saliva collection tubes.
